



# COMPOSTING guidelines



## ✓ Food Scraps



**Includes:** Meat, eggshells, vegetable trimmings, tea bags, pits, toothpicks, wine corks, nut shells, corn cobs



**Does Not Include:** Dairy items, egg yolks/whites, fat trimmings, grease, oil, fish skin, meat products, bones

## ✓ Compostable Papers



**Includes:** Napkins, tissues, paper towels, greasy or waxed cardboard, colored paper, magazines.



**Does Not Include:** Plastic coated items, chemical ridden towels, tissues with mucus, TP with biological matter, styrofoam

## ✓ Yard Waste



**Includes:** Grass clippings, leaves, small branches, plant trimmings, sawdust, string/twine made of natural fibers, pine cones, pine needles



**Does Not include:** Large logs, diseased plants, pet feces, dead animals, coal, ashes  
**All yard waste must be loose or in a compostable bag • NO plastic bags!**
